To Whom It May Concern:

I'm writing to express my concern, as a local public health official, for the lack of cooperation from the abovementioned facility with our office regarding our duties, as a health department, to conduct our State mandated disease surveillance and reporting.

Recently our office received a report of a staff person and patient who tested positive for COVID-19. Our Public Health Nurse reached out to the facility as part of the investigation into the individuals to instruct them on the requirements for isolation and to obtain a list of close contacts (contact tracing). The staff at the facility was not forth coming with the information.

As Agents for the local Board of Health my Public Health Nurses and I believe our role in the disease surveillance and reporting is extremely important to protect the staff and patients at this facility and the public in general. We would appreciate any assistance you can provide to ensure cooperation.
